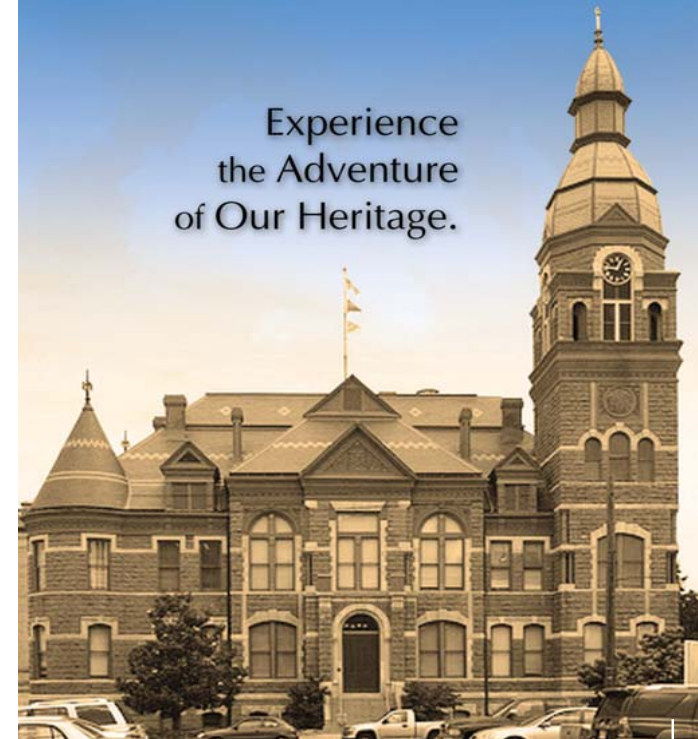

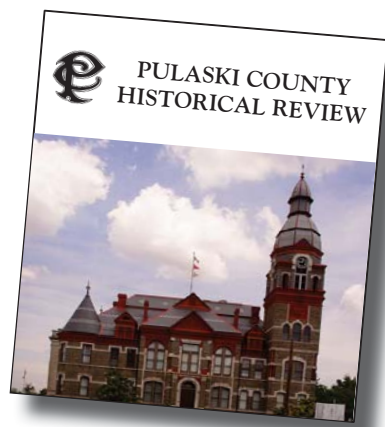
Pulaski County Historical Society

Society members receive the quarterly journal, the Pulaski County Historical Review. The Review is published through a partnership with the Butler Center for Arkansas Studies.

Four annual meetings plus a summer outing

The Society holds four meetings yearly that may include scholarly papers, slide presentations, or visits to historical sites. These are held on one Sunday in the months of February, April, September and November. Summer outings are held each June. (A notification is sent to members prior to each meeting.)

Awards

The PCHS presents F. Hampton Roy Awards each year- 1st place, \$300; 2nd place, \$200- for the best historical papers on a Pulaski County subject or individual.

Memberships run from January 1 to December 31. New memberships from October 1 to December 31 run through the following year.

The society is cognizant of other groups in the county, such as neighborhood associations, and seeks and welcomes members and input from these groups.
